To be eligible, applicants must:

- Be a graduating high school senior
- Be a Cook County, Illinois resident
- Demonstrate strong financial need
- Have a cumulative 3.0 unweighted GPA or higher
- Be a U.S. Citizen or U.S. Permanent Resident

 Be eligible to receive state and federal aid and will file the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)

How Do Students Apply?

Applicants must complete the online scholarship application, which includes writing three essay questions and securing two recommendations.

The online application is available on the Foundation's website on November 1st, and is due by **5:00pm CST on February 2, 2026**.
